**UWCC FEES** this year are as follows:

- 1) Student: \$145 (+ sports union fee)
- 2) Ordinary Member: \$165 (+ sports union fee)
- 3) Junior: \$75 (+ sports union fee)

Members will receive an early bird discount of \$20 if fees are paid by October 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Due to the introduction of VSU, **all** UWCC members (including non university students) must join the relevant University Sports Union, this consists of a one-off fee for the University year. If you have already played a winter sport, are a scholarship holder, or joined the gym you will already have paid this fee, otherwise you will need to pay this fee when you join UWCC.

- **Sydney University Sports Membership** is **\$55 for adults, \$11 for Juniors**. To join SU Sport please complete the form, and retain the **Pink** copy for your personal record. If you are already a member you still need to complete the form, and please quote your membership number (located on membership card) on the top right hand corner of the SU Sport form.
- **UNSW Sports Association** fee is **\$88**. Please quote your UNSW Sports Association membership number. If you are a UNSW student, but not a current member of UNSW Sports Association, please register for membership at UNSW Sports Association office.

## **MBF CLUB REBATE SCHEME**

The MBF Club Rebate Scheme is an agreement between Sydney University Sport and MBF which allows SU sporting clubs to receive an annual financial rebate for every member they sign up to the MBF Corporate Health Plan. The club will also receive a rebate for club members who are existing clients of MBF. All that is required is that the club member alert MBF to the fact that they are a member of an SU sporting club (UWCC) and that they are participating in the MBF Club Rebate Scheme.

The amount of money that is rebated to the club is proportionate to the number of members who sign up. For example, if 20 club members are signed up, the club will receive an annual payment of \$1579; if 50 members are signed up, \$3949, and so on. Even once a player leaves the club, if they stay with MBF the club will continue to receive a rebate for that ex-player.

This is an excellent opportunity for the club to make some money simply by encouraging our members to sign up with MBF Health and also asking members who are already with MBF to indicate that they are a member of UWCC, and become a part of this rebate scheme. Family members are also eligible to be included in this scheme. So if your parents or siblings want to sign up then they can do so through you! Likewise if you have family members who are already with MBF all that is required is you join your family member's rate plan, if you have not done so already.
